NFL Films-Produced Countdown Series Streams Exclusively on X, With Episodes Airing Later on NFL+

Two Players Revealed Each Weekday at 10 a.m. and 11 a.m. ET Through Aug. 21 – Players Ranked No. 100-11

Top 10 Revealed Over the Course of Two Weeks Aug. 24 – Sept. 4 – One Player Revealed Each Weekday at 10 a.m. ET

NEW YORK — June 10, 2026 — The new season of NFL Top 100 – the acclaimed player-voted countdown series from NFL Films and X – premieres Monday, June 22 exclusively on X. Produced by NFL Films, the X Original Series features short form episodes revealing the

league’s top players as voted on exclusively by current NFL players. Episodes debut weekdays on X beginning June 22 and running through Friday, Sept. 4, and will air later on NFL+, as well as other NFL owned-and-operated social media.

For players ranked No. 100-11, each weekday episode will feature two new player reveals (one at 10 a.m. ET and one at 11 a.m. ET) through Friday, Aug. 21. The top 10 will be announced over the course of two weeks with a player revealed each day at 10 a.m. ET from Aug. 24 through Sept. 4.

This marks the 16th consecutive year that current NFL players have voted to determine the top 100. Like last year’s edition of the series, NFL Top 100 embraces a short-form, digital-first

Atlanta, Baltimore, Miami, and D.C. advance in Tracy McGrady’s OBL‘lv1’ Hoops

Champion to be crowned on July 1



ORLANDO, Fla., June 12, 2026 -- Teams of 1v1 hoopsters representing Atlanta, Baltimore, Miami, and Washington, D.C. advanced at “OBL: Standing 6,” the second round of three Championship events for Tracy McGrady’s Ones Basketball League (OBL), held Friday at Oak Ridge High School. The teams of four 1v1 standouts battled it out in front of an enthusiastic crowd and nationwide audience on Fubu Sports Network and YouTube.

Washington, D.C. seeded first via tiebreaker with 24 points, followed by Baltimore with 24, Atlanta with 23, and Miami (20) to qualify for the Finals on July 1. New York (17 points) and Chicago (10) were eliminated with fifth and sixth place finishes, respectively.

“And then there were four,” said McGrady. “You could feel the intensity in every match as every

guy wanted to be the one to push his team to the top.”

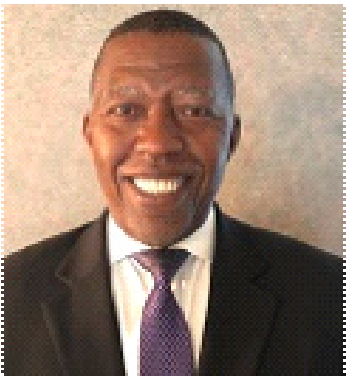

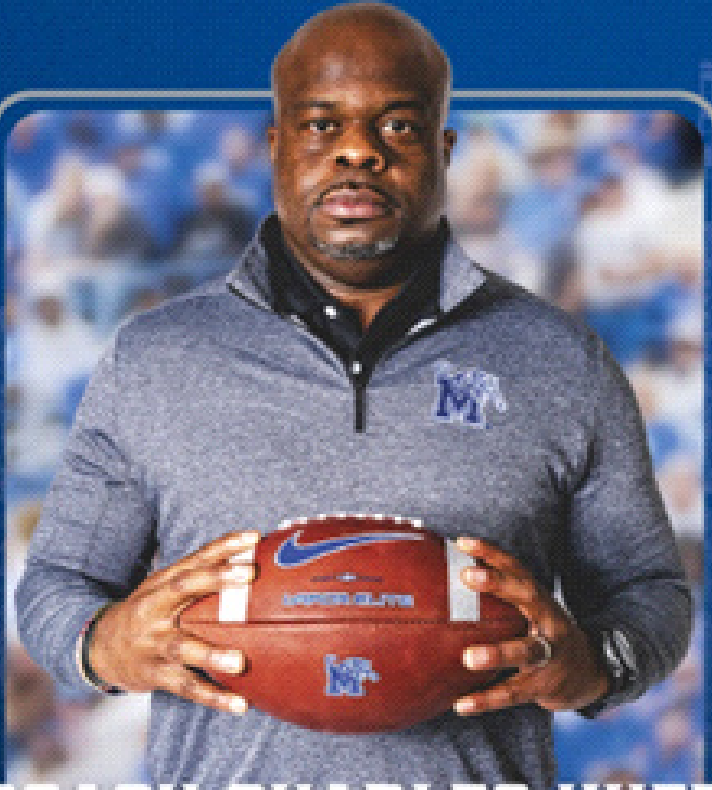
