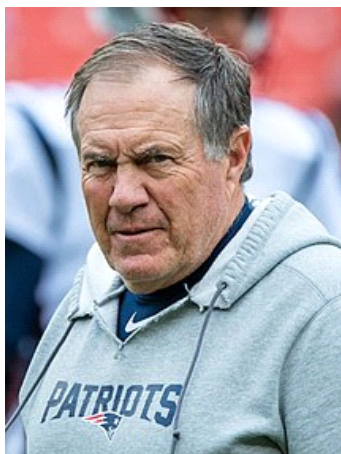

MEMPHIS, Tenn. July 17, 2024— The Allstate AFCA Good Works Team was announced Wednesday afternoon with Memphis' An'Darius Coffey named to the list.

Coffey, a redshirt-senior defensive back, appeared in a dozen games for the Tigers in 2023 making five starts. The Winona, Mississippi, native totaled 25 tackles, two tackles for loss, a sack, three pass breakups, a pair of quarterback hurries and a fumble recovery – including a season-high five stops in the win over Iowa State in the AutoZone Liberty Bowl.

Established in 1992, the Allstate AFCA Good Works Team recognizes college football athletes for their unwavering commitment to community service and their "good works" off the field.

"Inside the NFL" Returns for a Second Season on The CW on Friday, Aug. 30 at 9 p.m. ET/PT

BURBANK, Calif. — July 11, 2024 — The CW Network announced the most successful coach in NFL history and eight-time Super Bowl champion, Bill Belichick, will join the Emmy Award-winning "Inside the NFL" for its second season on The CW beginning Friday, Aug. 30 (9-10 p.m. ET/PT). Belichick will sit alongside Emmy Award-winning host and Super Bowl champion safety Ryan Clark, Pro Bowl wide receiver Chad Johnson and two-time Super Bowl champion defensive end Chris Long for a powerhouse panel combination of talent and experience as they dive deep into the most important stories and trends of the NFL season every week through the Super Bowl.

"Bill Belichick joining 'Inside the NFL' is a true game-changer for this storied franchise and The CW," said Dennis Miller, president, The CW Network. "Not only is he one of the most accom-

plished coaches in NFL history, but his knowledge and passion for football is truly unmatched. Fans will now get the chance to hear his insights and better understand the nuances of the game from the master himself. We cannot wait for Bill, Ryan, Chad and Chris to deliver a championship-caliber show all season long."

"I'm thrilled to join my new team at NFL Films and to work on such a historic television franchise," said Belichick. "I've always appreciated 'Inside the NFL's' depth of analysis, and I hope to bring the same detailed insight to The CW by talking real football with real pros – Ryan, Chris and Chad – this coming season."

"Over the years, NFL Films and Coach Belichick have enjoyed a long and collaborative relationship," said Steve Menzel, senior producer and showrunner, NFL Films. "Adding his football mind to an already impressive roster on 'Inside the NFL' presents an incredible creative opportunity."

Belichick is considered by many to be the greatest coach in NFL history. Over 24 seasons as head coach of the New England Patriots, his teams won an unprecedented nine AFC Championships and six Super Bowls. Before New England, he spent five years as head coach of the Cleveland Browns and won two Super Bowls as defensive coordinator of the New York Giants. In 2019, Belichick partnered with NFL Films on the series "NFL 100 All-Time Team," which won an Emmy Award and earned Belichick a nomination for Outstanding Studio Analyst. This year will mark his 50th straight season working in the National Football League.

Xander Schauffele remains No. 2 in the FedExCup standings; FedEx St. Jude Championship, August 14-18

MEMPHIS, Tennessee, July 23, 2024— With his second major championship title of the 2024 season at The Open Championship, San Diego native Xander Schauffele remains at No. 2 in the FedExCup Standings, while Nick Dunlap captured his second win of the season at the Barracuda Championship.

Golf's postseason begins at the 2024 FedEx St. Jude Championship Aug. 14-18, which invites the top 70 players in the FedExCup Playoffs and Eligibility



Points List at the conclusion of the regular season with only 50 players advancing to the following week's BMW Championship. TPC Southwind plays host to the four-day, no-cut opening Playoffs event for the third year.

Schauffele's win at Royal Troon Golf Club marks his ninth PGA

TOUR victory and second win this season, with his first title coming at the PGA Championship in May. Schauffele is set to make his eighth consecutive appearance at the FedEx St. Jude Championship, where he holds four top-25 finishes in seven starts (T17/2017; CUT/2018; CUT/2019; T25/2020; T16/2021; T57/2022; T24/2023).

Showboats acquire rights to 10 players thru 2024

MEMPHIS, Tenn. — The Memphis Showboats acquired the rights to 10 players in Wednesday's July 17) 2024 United Football League College Draft.

The Showboats selected six players on the offensive side of the ball and four defensive players. University of Kansas quarterback Jason Bean was Memphis' first pick and the No. 1 overall selection. The Showboats selected University of Memphis running back Blake Watson with the first pick of the second round.

The following is a look at each of the team's 10 selections:

Jason Bean - QB - Kansas / Rd. 1

- Led KU to a 9-4 record in 2023, passing for 2,130 yards with 18 touchdowns and 7 interceptions
- Added 280 yards and three touchdowns rushing
- Played previously at North Texas, accounting for 19 TDs (14 pass, 5 rush) with 5 interceptions in eight games
- Currently under contract to the Indianapolis Colts of the NFL

Blake Watson - RB - Memphis / Rd. 2

- Earned 2023 First Team All-

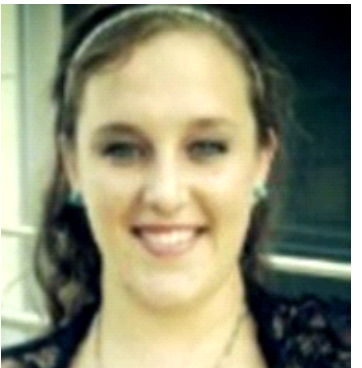
