Memphis Showboats DL Josiah Bronson signs with the New England Patriots

ARLINGTON, TEXAS, July 28, 2024 – The UFL has announced that Memphis Showboats defensive lineman Josiah Bronson has signed a contract with the New England Patriots of the National Football League.

In 10 games this season, Bronson had 12 tackles (9 solo/2 for loss) for the Showboats. He also recorded 1.5 sacks and a pass breakup.

A native of Covington, WA, Bronson spent one season at Temple before walking on at Washington and recorded 42 tackles and 3 sacks in 29 games for the Huskies.

The Memphis Showboats will

retain Bronson's rights should he return to the UFL.

The United Football League (UFL) is the premier spring football platform, formed by the merger of the XFL and USFL in 2024 under the combined ownership of Redbird Capital Partners, FOX, Dany Garcia and Dwayne Johnson. The UFL has eight teams in Arlington (TX), Birmingham (AL), Detroit (MI), Houston (TX), Memphis (TN), San Antonio (TX), St. Louis (MO), and Washington D.C.

QB Seth Henigan added to prestigious Maxwell 2024 Award Watch List

MEMPHIS, Tenn. July 28, 2024 – University of Memphis senior quarterback Seth Henigan was named to The Maxwell Award watch list, the Maxwell Club announced Monday morning. The Maxwell Award has been presented to the College Player of the Year since 1937 and is named in honor of Robert "Tiny" Maxwell who was a former standout at Swarthmore College and a re-

nowned sportswriter and football official.

In 2023, Henigan helped lead the Tigers to a 10-3 record and a victory over Iowa State in the 2023 AutoZone Liberty Bowl. The 21-year-old is entering his fourth season at the helm of the Tiger offense, making him the only fourth-year starting quarterback in FBS to spend all four sea-

sons at one institution.

The senior quarterback had his best season yet in 2023, passing for 3,883 yards and 32 touchdowns to just nine interceptions while rushing for another five scores and setting the single-season completions (318) record for the Tigers.

Henigan is the Memphis-career leader entering 2024 in completions (839) and passing yards (10,776) while his 79 touchdowns are just a dozen shy of Brady White's career record. The senior has logged 18-career 300-yard passing games and five 400-yard efforts over his career – both good for program records. If Henigan throws for his career average in passing touchdowns (26) in 2024, he would enter the NCAA's top-25 all-time in that stat and would become just the second QB since 2013 to post four-straight seasons with at least 25 total touchdowns.

Semifinalists for the Maxwell Award will be announced November 12, 2024, while the three finalists for the Maxwell Award will be unveiled November 26, 2024. The winners of the 88th Maxwell Award will be announced as part of the ESPN Home Depot College Football Awards Show held on December

Memphis was picked to win The American in the 2024 AAC Pre-season Media Poll with 23 of 30 first-place votes after putting together the fifth 10-win season in program history a year ago. The Tigers capped off the momentous 2023 season with a win over Iowa State in the 2023 AutoZone Liberty Bowl, holding the Cyclones to zero rushing yards.

The Tigers return a wealth of experience on both sides of the football. Key returners include fourth-year starting quarterback

Seth Henigan, three of the Tigers' four leading wide receivers from a year ago in Roc Taylor, Demeer Blankumsee and Koby Drake, tight end Anthony Landphere, running back and kick returner Sutton Smith, offensive linemen Xavier Hill and Jonah Gambill, Phil Steele Preseason All-American linebacker Chandler Martin and defensive back Greg Rubin. Including the aforementioned student-athletes, Memphis had 15 players named to Phil Steele's Preseason All-AAC Team.

Head coach Ryan Silverfield is entering his ninth season with Memphis (fifth as head coach). Silverfield has won a bowl title in each of his first four seasons and is the only head coach in program history with four bowl wins. His 31 wins are tied for the second most of any Memphis head coach through four seasons and are the fourth most among head coaches hired in 2020.

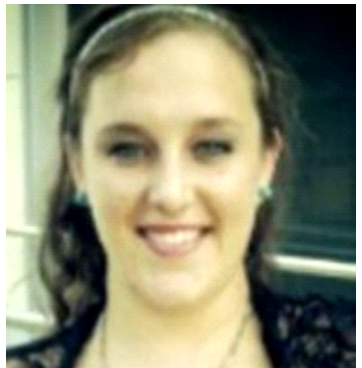

Judicial Watch files FCC complaint on Olympics vile opening ceremony

WASHINGTON, DC– Judicial Watch announced it filed a Federal Communications Commission (FCC) complaint this weekend against NBC for airing obscene and indecent content from the Olympics Opening Ceremony.

The Judicial Watch FCC complaint, filed by Judicial Watch President Tom Fitton reads, in part: NBC and its various

stations/outlets on TV, cable and Internet carried (and continues to make available) the Olympics Opening Ceremony on July 26, which included an adult male purposefully exposing (himself) in the presence of a child/children. This content is both obscene and indecent and, to make matters worse, was aired during viewing hours when it was likely
