

Memphis Tigers handle Troy for second straight victory

MEMPHIS- The Memphis Tigers football team scored its 2nd consecutive win with a 38-17 victory over Troy. The game was played at Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium on Saturday September 7, 2024. It was also the Tigers 2nd straight home game. The win put the Tigers at 2-0 for the young season.

The Tigers began the scoring on a 2-yard touchdown run from Brandon Thomas in the 1st quarter. Troy tied the game early in the 2nd quarter on an 11-yard touchdown run from Goose Crowder. Later in the 2nd, the Tigers got another touchdown run from Thomas and a touchdown run from Mario Anderson. The game was effectively sealed

The Tigers next play at Florida State who at one time was a top 10 team. After suffering 2 early season losses, the Seminoles have fallen. However, a win for the Tigers would keep them on pace to be the top ranked Group of 5 team. That gives them an automatic bid to the new 12 team College Football playoff. After the Troy win, the Tigers seem to be well on their way. They were ranked at 25 in the latest poll. It is their first top 25 ranking in nearly 4 years.

Grizzlies will sign Armando Bacot, Yuki Kawamura, Miye Oni and Maozinha Pereira

MEMPHIS, Tenn. September 6, 2024 – The Memphis Grizzlies announced the team signed forward/center Armando Bacot, guard Yuki Kawamura, guard Miye Oni and forward Maozinha Pereira. Per team policy, terms of the deals were not disclosed.

Bacot (6-11, 240) appeared in 169 games (168 starts) over his five-year collegiate career (2019-24) at North Carolina and averaged 13.9 points, 10.1 rebounds, 1.3 assists and 1.3 blocks in 28.2 minutes before going unselected in the 2024 NBA Draft. The 24year-old Richmond, Virginia, native left the Tarheels as the program's all-time leader in games played, total rebounds (1,715) and double-doubles (87), earned four All-ACC selections and helped guide UNC to the 2022 NCAA national champion-

Kawamura (5-8, 159) has competed the past five seasons (2019-24) in the Japanese B.League, where he was named the 2022-23 Most Valuable Player as a member of the Yokohama B-Corsairs. Unselected in the 2023 NBA Draft, the 23year-old started all 56 games for Yokohama last season and averaged 20.9 points, 3.0 rebounds and 8.0 assists in 30.6 minutes en route to a second straight selection to the B.League's Best Five team. Kawamura has represented Japan at the 2023 FIBA World Cup and the 2024 Paris Olym-

Oni (6-5, 206) has appeared in 80 regular season games (one start) and has averaged 1.8 points and 1.4 rebounds in 8.4

TN Titans host New York Jets in home opener at Nissan Stadium

NASHVILLE — The Tennessee Titans (0-1) play their first home game of the 2024 regular season this week, welcoming the New York Jets (0-0*) to Nissan Stadium (capacity 69,143). Kickoff is scheduled for noon CDT on Sunday, Sept. 15.

The Titans and Jets, two of the eight original American Football League franchises, renew their rivalry for the 47th time. While the Titans lead the series 25-20-1, including a postseason win in 1991, the Jets have claimed three of the last four battles, most recently a 27-24 overtime finish at MetLife Stadium on Oct. 3,



This week's game will be regionally televised on CBS, including Nashville affiliate WTVF NewsChannel 5, as well as on Paramount+ in the Nashville market. The broadcast team includes play-by-play announcer Ian Eagle, analyst Charles Davis and reporter Evan Washburn.

Fans in Nashville can stream live Titans games on mobile devices with NFL+, which offers access to local games and all primetime games on phones and tablets. Out of market, fans can watch every Sunday afternoon game with
