Tennessee State tops Arkansas Pine Bluff in 35th Annual Southern Heritage Classic event

MEMPHIS- The 35th annual Southern Heritage Classic took place at Simmons Liberty Bank Stadium in Memphis on September 14, 2024. It was the second straight year that the game pitted Tennessee State (TSU) against Arkansas Pine Bluff (UAPB). The Tigers of TSU pulled out the victory by a score of 41-28.

The Lions of UAPB began the scoring with a 33-yard touchdown pass from quarterback Mehki Hagans to JaVonnie Gibson. TSU kicked a field goal and

followed it up with a touchdown on a 3-yard Jalen Rousse run for a 10-7 first quarter lead.

TSU added to the lead with 3 touchdown passes from quarterback Dralen Ellis. He hit Karate Benson on a 22-yard pass. He followed that up with a 12-yard pass to Jordan Gant and a 4-yard pass to Jalal Dean. The Tigers went into the locker room at half time with a 31-14 lead.

The Tigers added to the lead early in the 3rd quarter on a 38yard touchdown run from C.J. Evans. That made the score 38-14. The lions would not go away quietly. Quarterback Mehki Hagans threw 2 touchdowns in the 3rd quarter to bring the Lions to within 10 points at 38-28.

The Lions ran out of gas in the 4th and could not manage to put any points on the board. TSU kicked a field goal to make it 41-

The crowd was large and what was thought to be a rainy day turned out to be nearly perfect. As always, the tailgating scene was huge around the stadium. Fans came out in droves to enjoy the festivities. Everyone is looking forward to year 36.

Over 62 players from modern spring football are currently signed with NFL teams

ARLINGTON, Texas (September 11, 2024) - The UFL continues to make a significant impact on the NFL, placing a substantial number of its players on NFL rosters prior to last weekend's start of the NFL sea-

Twenty-one players from the UFL's 2024 season are currently active in the NFL. Michigan Panthers kicker Jake Bates (Detroit Lions) and Arlington Renegades defensive tackle Jalen Redmond (Minnesota Vikings) both solidified a spot on a 53man roster when the NFL season began, while wide receiver Chris Blair (Atlanta Falcons) was recently promoted to the active roster from the practice squad. 14 others are signed to NFL team practice squads, and three are on injured reserve.

"We knew that merging both leagues would create more talented rosters which in turn would create a more entertaining product on the field. This would pro-

vide our players the competitive platform needed to be seen by NFL teams," stated UFL Executive Vice President, Daryl Johnston. "The number of workouts and signings we saw during NFL training camps speaks to the product we put on the field and the opportunity we created for our players as a league. This is

what spring football represents, providing a non traditional path to help players make it to football's grandest stage."

"The UFL has demonstrated to be a proven and effective product," said NFL Executive Vice President of Football Operations, Troy Vincent. "It provides an opportunity to develop, showcase and evolve the talent and quality of players, coaches, administrators, trainers and officials at the highest level of professional football."

After a successful inaugural season, over 250 of the 400 players (sixty percent) who appeared in games for the UFL were called to the NFL for workouts, with 78 individuals signing contracts to attend 30 NFL team training camps. Overall, the UFL saw 87 total contracts signed, which included eight players signing twice with the same team and one player signing three times with different teams.
