# Tennessee Titans make comeback to overcome Los Angeles Chargers

NASHVILLE, TN, Sept. 17-With a disappointing 15-16 loss against the New Orleans Saints to open the season, the Tennessee Titans faced off against the Los Angeles Chargers in their first home game on Sunday.

## TN Titans gear up to travel to Cleveland to face Browns


