

Memphis Tigers score big bounce-back win over Middle Tennessee

MEMPHIS, September 28, 2024- The Memphis Tigers returned home on Saturday September 28 to take on Middle Tennessee State at Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium. After a slow start, the Tigers pulled away for a 24-7 victory. After a disappointing upset loss to Navy last week, the Tigers needed this win to stay alive in the hunt for the College Football Playoff.

Quarterback Seth Henigan 26 of 41 for 227 yards. He did not have a touchdown pass in the game. That ended his streak of 41 games with a touchdown pass. After a scoreless 1st quarter, the Tigers got touchdown runs in the 2nd quarter from Brandon Thomas and Mario Anderson. They took a 14-7 lead into halftime.
