'NFL GameDay Kickoff' Airs at 7:00 AM ET

N.Y., N.Y. - The 2023 NFL London Games conclude with quarterback Lamar Jackson and the Baltimore Ravens facing running back Derrick Henry and the Tennessee Titans on Sunday, October 15 at 9:30 AM ET from Tottenham Hotspur Stadium EXCLUSIVELY on NFL Network. Ravens-Titans will also be available on local broadcast stations in Baltimore (WBAL) and Nashville (WTVF). Fans can also stream the game across devices with NFL+, the League's direct-to-consumer offering which is available through NFL digital properties (NFL.com and the NFL app), and on an authenticated basis through NFL Net-

work distributors' apps and sites and NFL platforms. Live game audio will be broadcast nationally by Westwood One, and carried on SiriusXM, the NFL app and NFL.com. For a full list of viewing options, fans can visit NFL.com/watch.

Play-by-play announcer Rich Eisen, game analyst Kurt Warner and sideline reporter Jamie Erdahl call the game.

Coverage on Sunday begins at 7:00 AM ET on NFL Network with NFL GameDay Kickoff, hosted by Chris Rose, Michael Irvin, Steve Mariucci and Steve Wyche from Los Angeles. Additionally, Insiders Ian Rapoport, Mike Garafolo and Tom Pelisero provide the latest news and information from around the league, and Steve Smith Sr. joins from London.

Titans cross 'pond' for showdown with Baltimore Ravens in London

Tennessee Titans (2-3) vs. Baltimore Ravens (3-2) Sunday, Oct. 15, 2023 • 8:30 a.m. CDT/2:30 p.m. BST • Tottenham Hotspur Stadium • London, U.K. • TV: NFLN & WTVF-5



NASHVILLE — The Tennessee Titans (2-3) travel to London this week to face the Baltimore Ravens (3-2). It will mark the Titans' second all-time game in London and their first appearance at Tottenham Hotspur Stadium (capacity 60,000). Kickoff is scheduled for 8:30 a.m. CDT/2:30 p.m. BST.

The Titans and Ravens have met on 26 prior occasions, highlighted by five postseason contests—most recently a 20-13 Ravens wild-card victory on Jan. 10, 2021. The Titans have faced the Ravens more than any other opponent in franchise postseason

history, despite the first such matchup not occurring until January 2001. Including all regular season and postseason games, the series is tied 13-13.

Sunday's contest will be nationally televised on NFL Network and streamed to mobile devices on NFL+. Local viewers in the Nashville market can also tune in to the game on WTVF

Tigers picked fifth in AAC Preseason poll; M. Griggs named Preseason First Team

MEMPHIS, Tenn. — With the start of the 2023-24 season around the corner, the American Athletic Conference has announced its Preseason All-Conference Coaches Poll and Teams.

Memphis, who finished the 2022-23 season in second place—the highest finish for the Tigers ever in the AAC, were picked to finish fifth this year. South Florida and last season's AAC Championship winners, East Carolina took the top two spots, respectively, while newcomer Rice and SMU occupied the number three and four slots.

Madison Griggs, a fifth-year senior from Memphis, Tenn., has

been named to the AAC's Preseason All-Conference First Team after her stellar performance last season. The 2022-23 All-AAC Third Team honoree averaged 12.3 points per game a year ago while draining 87 three-pointers. This is the first preseason honor for Griggs's career.

Designed by G-III, the product featured includes added functionality that has been seamlessly intertwined into the garments to allow for easier dressing.

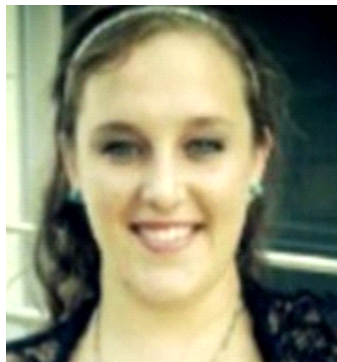

Three-Game pack for Memphis men's basketball now available

MEMPHIS, Tenn. — Memphis Athletics has announced a customizable 3-Game Pack for the upcoming 2023-24 men's basketball season, where fans can build their own package featuring one non-conference home game and two conference home games starting at only \$39.

Seating options are available for the 3-Game Pack throughout FedExForum, and the package can be purchased at gotigersgo.com or by calling the Memphis Ticket Office at (901) 678-2331.

Marquee non-conference home games on Memphis' 2023-24 slate include Vanderbilt (Dec. 23), Clemson (Dec. 16) and Virginia (Dec. 19), and American Athletic Conference matchups at home include games against Final Four participant Florida Atlantic (Feb. 25), UAB (March 3), Wichita State (Feb. 3) and Tulane (Feb. 11).

Fans interested in more than three games this season can consider a traditional season ticket or a Dynamic Pass, which includes a ticket to each home game with variable seating locations throughout the year so fans can enjoy different views at FedExForum, including the lower bowl, all season long. Season tickets and the Dynamic Pass can also be purchased online at www.GoTigersGoTix.com or by calling the Memphis Ticket Office.

Coming off an AAC Tournament title, a second-straight NCAA Tournament appearance and a fifth consecutive 20-win season, Memphis head coach Penny Hardaway brought in a top-15 class this season that features point guard and Alabama transfer Jahvon Quinerly, who scored over 1,100 points while winning two SEC regular season championships and two SEC

The Tigers also reeled in the reigning Lou Henson Award winner in 6-foot-11 big man Jordan Brown, who averaged 19.3 points, 8.6 rebounds and grabbed 10 double-doubles for Louisiana en route to being named first team all-conference and the Sun Belt Tournament MVP.

Another addition in the Tiger backcourt this season is Florida State transfer Caleb Mills, who started over 50 games for the Seminoles the last two seasons. In 2022-23, he averaged 13.0 points, 3.0 rebounds, a team-high 3.4 assists and 1.3 steals per game. Hardaway found another scorer in former Wichita State guard Jaykwon Walton, who led the Shockers with 13.9 points and 5.3 rebounds per game last season in 27 starts.

Additionally, Memphis added another big-time player in St. John's transfer David Jones. The 6-foot-6 forward started 17 games for the Red Storm last season, averaging 13.2 points and 6.8 rebounds per game. He logged seven double-doubles, rattled off double digits in 25 games and drained a team-high 42 triples.
