Memphis Tigers extend winning season openers with defeat over Missouri

MEMPHIS, Tenn. November 4, 2024- The University of Memphis men's basketball team opened its season with an 83-75, come-from-behind win over Missouri to extend its winning streak to 22 in home openers Monday night inside FedExForum in Memphis.

Memphis (1-0) trailed by 10 at the half but rallied to outscore Mizzou 51-33 in the second half behind 57.7-percent shooting (15-of-26).

In his debut game as a Tiger, redshirt-sophomore guard PJ Haggerty led the Tigers with a game-high 25 points – including 22 in the second half to lead the Memphis comeback. Last year's unanimous AAC Freshman of the Year went 10-for-11 from the charity stripe and added six boards and five assists.

Three more Tigers chipped in double-digit scoring efforts as former Big 12 Freshman of the Year Tyrese Hunter scored 14 points with four rebounds and a

pair of assists. Fifth-year center Moussa Cisse added 14 points himself to accompany seven rebounds from the bench. Redshirt-senior guard Colby Rogers added 10 points.

The Tigers were sluggish out of the gate, turning the ball over eight times and trailing by as many as 14 late in the first half. But 'Big Memphis' showed up after halftime and so did that vaunted Penny Hardaway defense

Memphis trailed 55-47 with just over 12 minutes remaining, but Hardaway's crew used an 11-0 run over the span of 2:28 to retake the lead for good after a fastbreak layup and three ball from Hunter on back-to-back possessions. Haggerty scored 13 points in the final 10 minutes and Cisse sank five free throws to ice the victory.

Missouri (0-1) was led by Anthony Robinson II's 16 points and seven assists. Tamar Bates

Tennessee Titans set to battle LA Chargers in SoFi Stadium

NASHVILLE — The Tennessee Titans (2-6) travel to Los Angeles this week to face the Chargers (5-3). Kickoff at SoFi Stadium (capacity 71,500) is scheduled for 1:05 p.m PST/3:05 p.m. CST on Sunday, Nov. 10.

Sunday marks the 50th all-time meeting between the Titans and Chargers franchises, two charter members of the American Football League. The Chargers lead the regular season series 28-16-1, while the Titans hold a 3-1 advantage in the playoffs.

The two clubs will square off for the third consecutive season. In their only previous encounter at SoFi Stadium, which opened in 2020, the Chargers defeated the Titans 17-14 on Dec. 18, 2022. Most recently, Tennessee pulled out a 27-24 overtime victory at Nissan Stadium on Sept. 17,



2023.

The contest will be regionally televised on FOX, including Nashville affiliate WZTV FOX 17. The broadcast team includes play-by-play announcer Kenny Albert, analyst Jonathan Vilma and reporter Megan Olivi.

Nick Folk provided a 25yard field goal in the extra period, and safety Amani Hooker then sealed the victory with his second interception of the day. For the third consecutive week, Mason Rudolph started at quarterback with Will Levis sidelined due to a shoulder injury. He passed for 240 yards, including touchdown passes to tight end Nick Vannett and wide receiver Nick Westbrook-Ikhine. He registered his third career gamewinning drive with his effort in
