MEMPHIS, November 16, 2024-It was Senior Day on Saturday, November 16 at Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium as the Memphis Tigers renewed their rivalry with Alabama-Birmingham. It was also a renewal of the Battle for the Bones, a trophy that goes to the winner of the game that pays homage to the barbecue traditions of both cities. The game was not much of a battle as the

Tigers held on to the bones after a 53-18 blowout.

Senior quarterback Seth Henigan was 23-34 for 299 yards and 4 touchdowns. It was his last home game for the Tigers. Running back Mario Anderson had 22 carries for 138 yards and a touchdown.

The Tigers led 18-8 at halftime. Many thought it may be a competitive game. However, the
