As a freshman state representative, Donalds bucked Republican leadership that bent the knee to gun control after Parkland and voted against SB 7026, the major post-Parkland gun control bill in the Florida House. He has continued that stand in Congress by opposing key federal gun control packages.

And in GOA's 2026 Florida Candidate Survey, he opposed one-gun-a-month laws, bans on commonly owned firearms like AR-15s and magazines, universal background checks, "Red Flag" gun confiscation orders, age-based purchasing restrictions on 18- to 20-year-olds, and many other gun control measures.

Donalds pledged his support for Constitutional Carry to be expanded to all law-abiding adults 18 and older, repealing Florida's Red Flag law, bump stock ban, and strengthening preemption laws with real enforcement teeth to prevent cities and counties from running roughshod over Floridians' gun rights.

Luis Valdes, Florida State Director of Gun Owners of America, issued the following statement: "Byron Donalds answered every question in our survey, but actions speak louder than words. He has a proven record of standing firm for the Second Amendment. Donalds has made repealing red flag laws 'job one' and understands that the right to keep and bear arms is the ultimate constitutional safeguard of our liberties. Gun owners can trust Byron Donalds to protect and expand our rights as governor."

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SAF throws support behind former Virginia AG’s assault weapons ban challenge

BELLEVUE, Wash. — June 15, 2026 — The Second Amendment Foundation (SAF) has agreed to help support former Virginia Attorney General Ken Cuccinelli in a challenge to the state’s newly passed “assault weapons” ban.

In May, Virginia Gov. Abigail Spanberger signed into law a ban on so-called “assault firearms” declaring that “...any person who imports, sells, manufactures, purchases, or transfers an assault firearm is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.” The law further defines an “assault firearm” as a semiautomatic rifle chambered in any caliber besides .22 rimfire or one that contains a litany of common features. The law also bans magazines capable of holding more than 15 rounds of ammunition and goes into effect on July 1.

“Unlike other lawsuits filed challenging this ‘assault weapons’ ban, this case is unique in that plaintiffs are arguing they have the right to buy the banned arms to preserve their ability to

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Memphis Safe Task Force surpasses 10,000 arrests; U.S. Marshals capture man on the run for 21 months

Jackson, TN - The U.S. Marshals Two Rivers Violent Fugitive Task Force (USMS) caught up with a man on the run for 21 months who has a history of evading law enforcement.

Mickel Marable, 27, was captured by the USMS at a residence in the 500 block of Westside Drive in Humboldt, TN. Marable was wanted on two separate warrants. The first one originated from a September 10, 2024, traffic stop in Jackson when a Jackson Police Officer pulled over a vehicle driven by Marable on Old Hickory Blvd. near the Highway 45 By-Pass.

It is alleged that while being questioned by the Officer during the stop, Marable ran away leading the Officer on a foot chase through a nearby apartment complex. Marable was able to make his way back to his vehicle and speed away. The Officer returned to his vehicle and attempted to catch up to Marable, but he was able to get away.

was issued in Jackson City Court on September 11, 2024. The second warrant was for violation of probation issued in August 2025. Marable was on probation in Tennessee after being convicted of aggravated assault and evading arrest on April 9, 2024.

A Report from The Memphis Safe Task Force (MSTF)

MEMPHIS, Tenn, June 10, 2026 – The Memphis Safe Task Force on Tuesday, June 9, executed 42 arrests and seized eight firearms, reaching a milestone of more than 10,000 arrests and recovering 1,708 illegal firearms since the operation began in September 2025.

“This is a significant milestone for the dedicated men and women working around the clock to end street and violent crime in Memphis,” said Tyreece Miller, U.S. Marshal for the Western District of Tennessee. “By removing these illicit firearms from Memphis streets and making 10,000 arrests, we have achieved unprecedented results, not just for the Task Force, but for all the residents and visitors to our beloved city.
