WASHINGTON—United States Senators Bill Hagerty (R-TN) and Tim Kaine (D-VA) applauded Senate passage of their Forgotten Heroes of the Holocaust Congressional Gold Medal Act (S. 91), a bill to honor 60 World War II-era diplomats from the United States and around the world who risked their careers and, in many instances, their lives to save others during the Holocaust.
