

Wrap-up: Memphis beats Navy in rifle match held at R.F. Fogelman Rifle Range

No. 10 Memphis Beats No. 13 Navy, 4699-4689

MEMPHIS, Tenn. – The No. 10ranked University of Memphis rifle team defeated No. 13 Navy, 4699-4689, on Sunday, Oct. 22 at the R.F. Fogelman Rifle Range. The Tigers (2-2, 1-2 GARC) fell in smallbore, 2329-2327, but bounced back to win air rifle, 2372-2360.

"I'm happy with today's match and to see us in a consistent spot from last weekend," head coach Morgan Phillips said. "The team worked hard today, and I think we're in a great spot to continue to improve heading into a doubleheader this coming weekend. It's also been great to see some standout individual performances. This was the second weekend in a row that Kenlee shot a personal best. Gabriela also tied the program air rifle record today. I'm very happy to see us hitting these marks this early in the season."

- Sophomore Gabriela Zych was tremendous for the Tigers on Sunday, taking first overall in the individual standings with an aggregate score of 1184.
