securing its fate prior to sunsetting your watch by using the Presidential Antiquities Act to bring the property into the National Trust. Placing the cabin under the National Park System's management would ensure its preservation into perpetuity. We suggest this designation be accomplished as a standalone entity or by appendage to the Camp Nelson (Nicholasville, KY or the Charles Young and Buffalo Soldiers National Monument (Wilberforce, OH).

We thank you again for your life in service and honoring our na-

tion's hero with his posthumous promotion, by the U.S. Department of Defense, in November 2022. It was an honor to celebrate Brigadier General Young's promotion the following February with his family members, Kentucky; United States military leaders and veterans; community

leaders, and public officials, as well as his promotion ceremony at the US Military Academy West Point, in April 2023.
