TN Titans host NFC champion 49ers

FIRST LOOK AT CALLA-HAN'S TITANS

In addition to Callahan and the coaching staff, the Titans' 91man roster includes 35 members playing for the first time in twotone blue (as of Aug. 4). Executive vice president/general manager Ran Carthon spearheaded the acquisitions of free agents such as cornerback Chidobe Awuzie (formerly with the Bengals), linebacker Kenneth Murray Jr. (Chargers), defensive lineman Sebastian Joseph-Day (49ers), center Lloyd Cushenberry III (Broncos), running back Tony Pollard (Cowboys), safety Jamal Adams (Seahawks), and wide receivers Calvin Ridley (Jaguars) and Tyler Boyd (Bengals). Former Kansas City Chiefs cornerback L'Jarius Sneed was acquired in a trade. In the draft, the team used its first selection (seventh overall) on Alabama tackle JC Latham.

Quarterback Will Levis is poised to begin his second preseason and his first as the team's starting signal caller. The 33rd-overall pick in the 2023 NFL Draft stepped into the lineup seven games into his rookie season and eventually totaled nine starts. He completed 149 of 255 passes for 1,808 yards with eight touchdowns and four interceptions.

After facing the 49ers on Saturday, the Titans will play their second home preseason game a week later against the Seattle Seahawks (Aug. 17). Before meeting at Nissan Stadium, the two teams will conduct joint practices at Ascension Saint Thomas Sports Park in Nashville on Aug. 14 and 15. The Titans close the preseason with a trip to play the New Orleans Saints on Aug. 25.

THE 49ERS

In 2023, the 49ers finished the regular season with a 12-5 record to claim their second consecutive NFC West title. They advanced to Super Bowl LVIII, ultimately falling in overtime to the Kansas City Chiefs. It

while rushing for another five scores and setting the single-season completions (318) record for

the Tigers. Henigan is the Memphis-career leader entering 2024 in completions (839) and passing yards (10,776) while his 79 touchdowns are just a dozen shy of Brady White's career record. The senior has logged 18-career 300yard passing games and five 400-yard efforts over his career - both good for program records. If Henigan throws for his career average in passing touchdowns (26) in 2024, he would enter the NCAA's top-25 all-time in that stat and would become just the second QB since 2013 to post four-straight seasons with at least 25 total touchdowns.

The 2024 Walter Camp Player of Year watch list will be narrowed to 10 semi-finalists in early November and three finalists will be announced on November 26. The 2024 Walter Camp Player of the Year recipient, which is voted on by the 133 NCAA Football Bowl Subdivision head coaches and sports information directors, will be announced on ESPN's College

Football Awards Show on December 12.

Key returners include fourth-year starting quarterback Seth Henigan, three of the Tigers' four leading wide receivers from a year ago in Roc Taylor, Demeer Blankumsee and Koby Drake, tight end Anthony Landphere, running back and kick returner Sutton Smith, offensive linemen Xavier Hill and Jonah Gambill, Phil Steele Preseason All-American linebacker Chandler Martin and defensive back Greg Rubin. Including the aforementioned student-athletes, Memphis had 15 players named to Phil Steele's Preseason All-AAC Team.

Head coach Ryan Silverfield is entering his ninth season with Memphis (fifth as head coach). Silverfield has won a bowl title in each of his first four seasons and is the only head coach in program history with four bowl wins. His 31 wins are tied for the second most of any Memphis head coach through four seasons and are the fourth most among head coaches hired in 2020.

activities, including as voter registration, ballot drop-off, early voting, or Election Day sites. The stadiums that will be used for election-related activities will be announced on a rolling basis. All NFL league and club personnel, including players, coaches and staff, will be required to participate in a mandatory "Voting 101" education course. This session will provide thousands of participants with a broad overview of the electoral process and voting requirements, including information on voter registration.
