MEMPHIS, TENN., April 30, 2024 -A USFL Conference rivalry matchup is on tap Saturday at Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium. Memphis will be looking to avenge a 33-14 loss at the and No. 2 scoring offense in the hands of the Stallions in Birmingham in Week 3. Birmingham is 5-0 and coming off back-toback USFL Championship seasons. Memphis has lost its last four since winning the opener. But a victory for the Showboats could put them back on a trajectory to contend for a playoff berth. Michigan has alternated wins and losses since Week 1,

defeating St. Louis and Houston in Weeks 1 and 3 and falling to Birmingham and San Antonio in Weeks 2 and 4. The Stallions feature the No. 1 total offense UFL. Birmingham's defense is also among the league's best, ranking No. 1 in scoring defense and No. 2 in total defense. Saturday's game is slated for an 11 a.m. CT kickoff and will be broadcast nationally on ABC.
