manity. A country is at its best when freedom and liberty are celebrated, truth is upheld, and children take priority. And this priority includes their protection. Children are God's greatest gift to us, and I believe we all must do everything possible to protect them. So does Lee," Millben said

"This song will not only elevate March for Kids and bring inspiration to America's moms, dads, grandparents, and guardians, but I truly believe every American and global citizen will be singing this song for years to come. Our kids are our future and hope," Millben said.

With seven #1 songs & 25 charted singles to his credit, choosing songs proved to be a success for Greenwood. Lee Greenwood has won numerous industry awards including, Male Vocalist of the Year from the Academy of Country Music in 1983, two Male Vocalist of the Year awards from the Country

Music Association in 1983 & 1984 and a Grammy for Top Male Vocal Performance in 1985 for "I.O.U.". The CMA also named "God Bless The U.S.A." its Song of the Year in 1985.

"God Bless the U.S.A." went far beyond what Greenwood expected when he wrote it in the back of his tour bus in 1983. The song has been in the top five on the country singles charts three times (1991, 2001 and 2003), giving it the distinction of being the only song in any genre of music to achieve that feat. It was also #1 on the pop charts after 9/11/01. In addition, CBS News voted "God Bless The U.S.A." the most recognizable patriotic song in America. Having performed for five consecutive U.S. Presidents, 2024 marks the 40th anniversary of "God Bless The U.S.A.!"

Millben is a story of the American dream. A preacher's daughter from Oklahoma, Millben has performed the National Anthem and patriotic music for four consecutive U.S. Presidents - President George W. Bush, President Barack Obama, President Donald Trump, and President Joe Biden, international royalty, and world leaders. Millben has been featured at the 58th Presidential Inauguration Victory Celebration for President Trump, The White House, the United States Congress, 2024 International Cricket

Council T20 World Cup, for the National Football League (NFL), National Basketball Association (NBA), Major League Baseball (MLB), 2016 RIO Olympics, off-Broadway, in India, China, Europe, Canada, Africa, and in concert halls worldwide. Pairing her message of unity with diplomacy, Millben has gained international recognition for her performances of global anthems for India, China, Brazil, UAE, Israel, and other G20 countries.

February 2020, Notefornote Entertainment released Millben's debut single "Grace Will Lead Me Home" on THE MEANEST MAN IN TEXAS original motion picture soundtrack now on all leading digital platforms globally and received Academy Award/Oscar eligibility. "Grace Will Lead Me Home" was written for THE MEANEST MAN IN TEXAS and the film is available on Amazon Prime Video. Millben is devoted to using her voice and platform to share God's love to hearts and lands globally.

Bierman and Kitagawa earn AAC Weekly honors

IRVING, Texas, August 26,2024 – Senior goalkeeper Kaylie Bierman won the AAC's second Goalkeeper of the Week award, while freshman midfielder Ai Kitagawa collected her second straight AAC Freshman of the Week honor, the conference announced Monday.

The accolades come on the back of the No. 8/10 Tigers' 2-1 victory over Ole Miss on Sunday evening, which improved their 2024 record to 3-0.

Bierman was instrumental in stifling Ole Miss' attack on Sunday in Oxford, collecting two official saves and diving to collect several loose balls. The only Rebel goal, the first allowed of Bierman's season in 225 minutes, came through a penalty kick.

Kitagawa continued her sensational start to her Memphis career, scoring the Tigers' two goals to up her tally to three on the season. She is the fastest player to reach three career goals in the Brooks Monaghan era (2000-present).

This is the second award for both Bierman and Kitagawa in their respective careers. Bierman was named Goalkeeper of the Week in August 2023 while Kitagawa makes it two Freshman of the Week awards in as many weeks.

Memphis will be back in action this Sunday, Sept. 1, when they host Iowa State at 8 p.m., the second game of a double header at the Track and Soccer Stadium.
