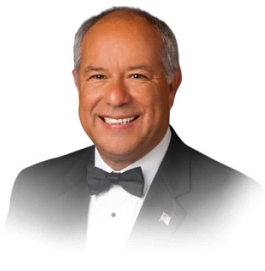
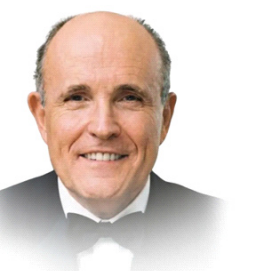
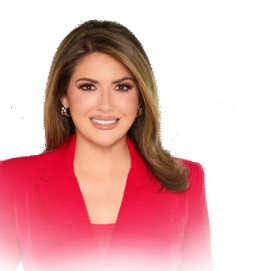
This black-tie gala will commemorate 250 years of American prosperity and spotlight the growing role of the Latino community in shaping the economic, cultural, and civic development of the United States.

•**Betray Thirst** shifts the lens to professional power, as a successful attorney risks everything when he crosses an unforgivable line with a client, unraveling his carefully built life.

•**The Stix** brings viewers to rural West Tennessee, where narcotics investigators pursue a local drug kingpin facing mutiny within his own organization, blending law enforcement pressure with internal criminal conflict.

•**Cubic Zirconia** is a tense investigative drama in which detectives race to locate missing children after their mother is found deceased, uncovering a case defined by deception and false appearances.

•**Cards & Cognac** closes the collection on an intimate note, following four men who honor a fallen friend through a tradition of card games and candid conversations that expose grief, brotherhood, and long-buried truths.

Together, the films position Lockridge as a filmmaker deeply interested in moral complexity, emotional realism, and stories
