Lifetime announces five all-new hot movies for July and August when the heat is on fiery intense drama

LOS ANGELES, CA - JUNE 17, 2026 – Lifetime heats up the summer with five all-new movie premieres airing Saturdays at 8/7c throughout July and August. Starting July 11, Christina Milian (Dexter: Original Sin, Falling Inn Love) stars in He Couldn't Let Go, as Mariana, a woman whose ability to read body language helps her escape a terrifying ordeal. On July 18, Danielle Panabaker (The Flash) and Anwen O'Driscoll star in Crowning at the Prom. Inspired by real events, the film follows a single mother (Panabaker), who discovers her teenage daughter has been hiding a life-changing secret. Premiering July 25, Girl in the Coffin stars Tahirah Sharif (The Haunting of Bly Manor) as Jasmine, a woman who must fight for survival after waking up trapped inside a coffin. Continuing on August 1, Killer Clown, inspired by real stories, stars Sara Paxton (Weapons) as a woman haunted by her mother's murder at the hands of a local killer. The slate is rounded out on August 8 with She Stole My Son's Heart, starring Marisol Nichols (Riverdale) as a homicide detective who works alongside her rookie counterpart to find a kidnapped woman who desperately needs a heart transplant.
